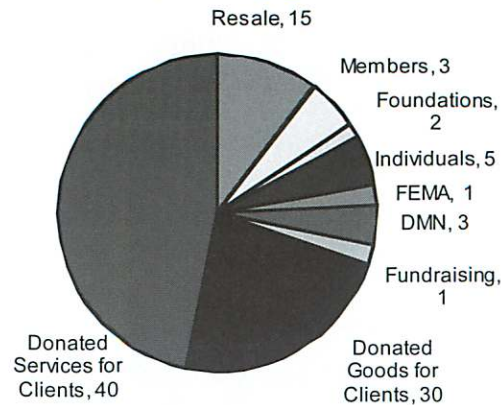

## Sources of Support

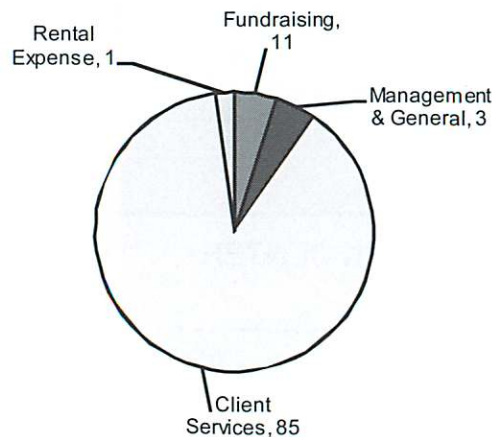


Donated Goods and Services provide 70% of our support

## Through the Center of Hope...

You can provide people who are temporarily unable to provide for themselves and their families with help and hope.

*Through your donations and contributions, you can:*

- Provide groceries tailored to the family's size and needs.
- Provide each family member with the opportunity to select up to five outfits of clothing per person four times a year with the change of seasons.
- Assist them with their rent payment to insure their remaining in their home.
- Assist with utility payments to guarantee their access to vital services such as water, electricity and gas.
- Assist with transportation in the form of bus passes.
- Counsel the family on how to deal with this temporary crisis.
- Refer the family to government and/or social service agencies that might be able to assist.
- Confirm God's love for them.
